

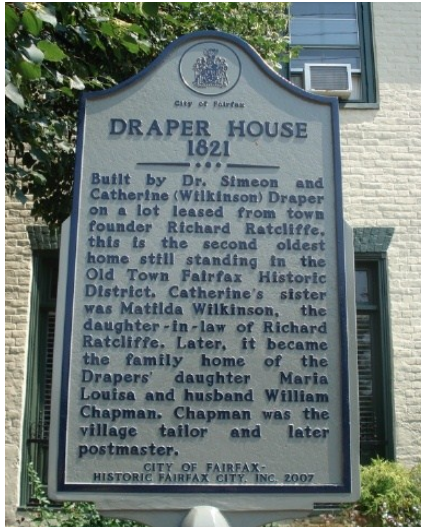

DRAPER HOUSE FAIRFAX, VA

Design and administration services for the renovation of the Historic Draper House. The work included floor reinforcement, adding the required fire egress stairs, upgrading the electrical service and adding a sprinkler system.

Originally built by Dr. Samuel Draper, this house served as his home, office, and examining room. Its Flemish bond brickwork, box-like appearance and large end chimneys are typical of Federal style architecture. Many

of the structure's original out-buildings have been converted into shops.

This is the second oldest home still standing in the Old Town Fairfax Historic District.
