A \$750M embassy compound. The project consists of design of a new embassy office building, office annex building, marine security guard quarters, general services office and warehouse, central utility plant, site utilities and infrastructure, compound access facilities, demolition of existing buildings, and design of permanent staff housing, recreational and support structures. The project is designed for energy efficiency and performance as well as to maximize the health, safety and welfare of the compound

community. Intensive water conservation measures, high performance mechanical equipment, daylight harvesting, solar water heating, and a design featuring highly integrated materials and systems will yield a highly sustainable compound, certified "LEED Silver" under the campus approach to the U.S. Green Building Council.
