MOULTRIE COURTHOUSE—C STREET EXP WASHINGTON, DC

An expansion of the existing courthouse intended to modernize, reorganize, and enlarge the Moultrie Courthouse. The project increases capacity by creating six technologically sophisticated criminal courtrooms, providing chambers for 21 judges, constructing approximately 175,000 SF of new and renovated office space for Family Court related functions, and improving space for Jurors, Child Care, and the US Marshals Service.

The addition will be six stories, will be designed to meet current progressive-collapse requirements, and will be supported on concrete auger piles. The project has been designed to achieve LEED Gold certification.
