MT. LEBANON SAFETY CENTER

MT. LEBANON, PA

A \$9 million, 47,000 SF three story public safety center with basement adjacent to the Port Authority's below grade metro tunnel. The building holds both the fire and police departments and includes space for eight vehicles, sleeping quarters, kitchen areas, office space and a 3,000 SF training area. The basement houses holding cells, interviewing rooms, along with rooms for conducting interviews and field sobriety tests, writing reports, fingerprinting arrestees, and storage of weapons and evidence.

The construction is a steel framed building and has a foundation of drilled piers. A portion of the building is in the right of way of the Port Authority on the ground level and the remaining two levels cantilever over the Port Authority right of way.

The apparatus bays are located above the below grade basement level.
