SMITHSONIAN INSTITUTE TERM CONTRACT

The structural design, documentation and cost estimating for renovations to add stairs and elevators, mezzanine and storage room additions, recapturing existing space for new uses and supporting some of the more elaborate exhibits within various Smithsonian Museums.

Example projects include:

- National Air & Space Museum—Renovation of existing gift shop to add elevator and new mezzanine.
- Freer Gallery—Install new mezzanine for exhibit space.
- Natural History Museum—Add stairways and elevator and renovate existing stair for access to existing mezzanine.
- National Zoo—Waterfront exhibit.
- Museum of Asian Art—Design hanging 66 foot by 90 foot exhibit frame.
- Museum of African Art—New mezzanine structure with access ramp and stairs.
